To improve driver recruiting, retention and comfort, the maintenance director at Central Trucking, Inc. (CTI), Mark Stahl, went in search of a more robust auxiliary power unit (APU) for the company's fleet. A premier coast-to-coast carrier, CTI's fleet includes 253 refrigerated trailers. CTI has solo and team drivers relaying to and from four terminals across the United States. Stahl wanted an APU that would deliver highly-reliable backup power for longer periods of time. Idle Free® electric APU and Reefer Link®, Phillips & Temro Industries (PTI) brands, exceeded CTI's requirements. These SmartWay-verified technologies also reduce fuel consumption, allowing for a greener fleet with virtually indefinite idle-free heating, cooling and 120V power for sleeper-berth comforts.

"We had issues with our previous APU. The batteries would run down and there was little to no dealer support. We lost drivers because the previous product didn't provide the backup power needed to meet the hours of service (HOS) regulation requirements and give our over-the-road drivers the off-duty sleeper-bunk comforts they need," says Stahl.











"During our search for a better solution, PTI's Idle Free development engineer, Robert Jordan, met with us and explained the advantages of the Idle Free eAPU™ and Reefer Link Systems."

When Jordan learned of the problem he recommended the company's reefer-based APU, a year-round solution for sleeper trucks pulling refrigerated trailers. The Idle Free APU is affordable, recharges in just 4 to 6 hours and has been proven by a third-party test laboratory to run up to 10 hours. When combined with Reefer Link, virtually unlimited run time is possible. Reefer Link is an electrical connection between truck and refrigerated trailer.

CTI had the dealer install the Idle Free APU and Reefer Link products on new trucks starting in 2013. Specified with a 200-amp alternator, the trucks have experienced no alternator wear resulting from use of the products. The remainder of the fleet was converted to the technologies as new trucks were bought in 2014 through 2016.

"Our drivers really like the reefer-based Idle Free APU. They benefit from a comfortable temperature in the bunk, a warm engine and access to a television and computer," says Stahl. "When we hire a new driver, they review our video that goes over the Idle Free unit. The product is really important when our drivers require a 34hour restart."

Combined Idle Free's APU and Reefer Link can save up to 600 gallons (2,271 L) of diesel fuel per year over diesel APUs—and up to 3,000 gallons (11,256 L) of fuel per year versus idling truck engines. Idle Free's eAPUs and Reefer Link are easy to install and provide engine pre-heat to eliminate the risks of cold starts. The systems offer minimal maintenance and a two-year warranty.
